This certificate would be appropriate for students interested in drafting, architecture, interior design, property management, real estate, construction/management, showroom management, etc. Students will also have the opportunity to travel to Design + Construction Week each year. This certificate is offered to both degree-seeking students as well as non-degree seeking students desiring professional or personal advancement. Non-degree seeking students will be admitted to the University via established admission guidelines.
